

Prototyping Plan Template

This template will help you to map out a simple plan for prototyping. It asks the prototyper to think through what they want to learn, who they want to learn from, and what questions they want to ask in each testing session.

How to Use It

Complete this activity several days before embarking on testing.

Complete the plan together with a co-designer so that it is tailored to the community where the testing will happen.

Block 1 hour to complete the whole plan and facilitation guide

What Next?

Once the plan is completed remember to role play a few practice interviews or testing sessions, before going out to the community.

Testing Plan Template

What do you want to learn?
Aim for 2-3 overarching learning questions, and nest any more detailed questions within those.

Who do you need to learn from?
Describe the profile of someone you'd like to learn and get feedback from. Think about age, location, background, & role in relation to what you are designing. Determine how many people you need and where you might encounter them.
